Excursion to EtnaTuesday 22/3

On Tuesday, March 22nd, after the arrival at the hotel at Mt Etna, you will be introduced to the volcanic activities to be carried out on the field and workshops that will follow. After lunch we will take a short walk to Mt Rossi (1,700 mt) on the south side of the volcano. Here you will see the morphology of the rocks of the activity of the volcano as well as the area of Hornitos (on Monte Concilio and Pietra Cannone) which is a particular area of eccentric craters where the lava signs are particularly evident.

Activities:

Practical demonstration with tools used for the monitoring of volcanic geochemical activity and temperature analyses on fumaroles.

Students will mesure temperatures with the help of volcano experts, they will test CO2, H2 and CH4 as well as carry out sampling of volcanic minerals and gases with acid base reactions.
